A morning drive will take us past Pinnacle Mountain and then up Mount Petit Jean, where after a short stop we'll continue on to have lunch at Fat Daddy's BBQ in London, AR.

Most luncheon choices are around \$10, and there is usually a daily special.

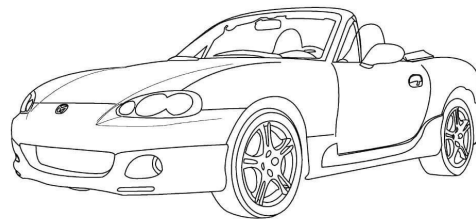
