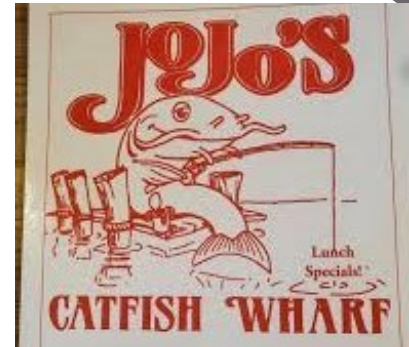

“HOLIDAY PARTY LUNCH”***SATURDAY, DECEMBER 5th******11:00am******Cheers in Maumelle***

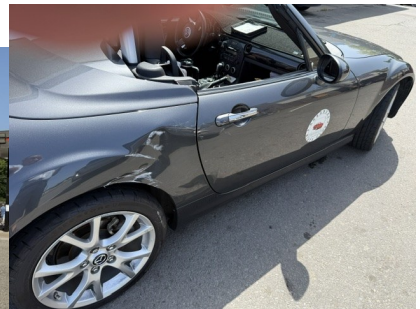

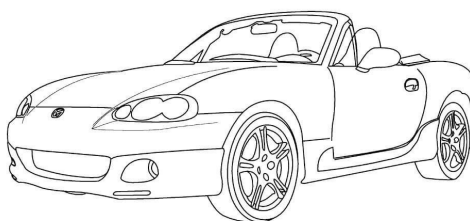
